6 Days - 5 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the one your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- Day 1** Depart from Scranton, PA aboard your motorcoach and head south toward Tennessee with a lunch stop on your own en route to Wytheville, VA where overnight lodging has been arranged for you (*pack an overnight bag*); dinner is on your own this evening.
- Day 2** Breakfast, then continue to **Nashville - The Home of Country Music**. Upon arrival you will enjoy a ride on the Delta Flatboats. The museum features an array of rare costumes, instruments, historical mementos and tear-stained lyric sheets which serve to entertain and educate audiences from all over the world. Afterwards, you enjoy lunch on your own and free time in downtown Nashville. Visit the Honky Tonks on Broadway, a breeding ground for hopeful performers, musicians, and songwriters. While in the downtown area, enjoy a **self-guided tour of the Ryman Auditorium**, the original home of the Grand Ole Opry. Return to your hotel to freshen up before dinner. This evening's **dinner will be at Paula Deen's Family Kitchen to include a Songwriter's Session**.
- Day 4** Enjoy breakfast, then meet your guide for a **Highlights Driving Tour of Nashville**. You will see some of the well-known Nashville neighborhoods and a photo stop at the **Parthenon**, which is the world's only full scale replica of the original Parthenon in Athens. Afterwards, arrive at the Opryland Docks to board the **General Jackson Riverboat for a luncheon cruise with entertainment**. This afternoon enjoy free time for shopping and dinner on your own at the **Opry Mills Complex**. Your day will end with a fabulous show at the **Grand Ole Opry**. The Grand Ole Opry blends the excitement of a live audience, the heritage of the world's longest-running live radio show, and an incredible mix of talent.
- Day 5** Following breakfast, check out and depart for a visit to the **Belle Meade Plantation which includes a tour, lunch and wine tasting**. After your visit, return to Wytheville, VA for overnight lodging (*pack an overnight bag*); dinner is on your own this evening.
- Day 6** After breakfast, check out and continue homeward - taking with you fond memories of your vacation in **Nashville, TN!**
